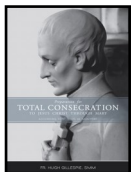

Total Consecration to Jesus Through Mary



For the 29th consecutive year, parishioners of St. Agnes will be preparing for the Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary, as developed by St. Louis Marie de Montfort. The 33-day period of preparation begins on **Sunday, August 6th** (Transfiguration of our Lord) and culminates on **Thursday, September 7th** (vigil of the Nativity of The Blessed Virgin Mary). The prayers are said personally and individually. The date and time of the Mass and Consecration, which will be public for all who have prepared, will be announced in a future bulletin.

The prescribed guidebook, **Preparation for Total Consecration according to St. Louis Marie de Montfort**, is available for sale at the bookstore and the rectory office.

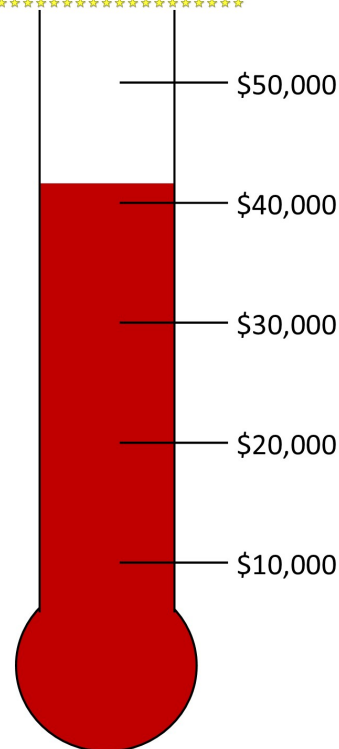

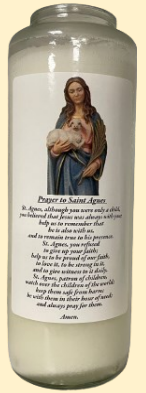


Special Edition
