Novus Ordo Latin Mass

Dear Parishioners and Friends,



In our recent questionnaire, one of the questions was about celebrating the Mass in Latin from time to time in the Novus Ordo form, which is the Mass of St. Paul VI following Vatican Council II. A large majority of people showed interest, so we decided to celebrate this Mass once a month at 12:30 pm on Sundays. To be clear, this is not the Tridentine Latin Mass.

The first Mass in Latin will be on **Sunday, October 1**st, **at 12:30 pm**. You can follow the Mass using the Missal in the pew, and we will prepare the parts of the Mass in English and Latin to help the faithful respond correctly to the dialogue in Latin. The Readings and the Gospel will be in English (and the homily!). Our plan is to celebrate the Mass in Latin on the first Sunday of every month at 12:30 pm, and see how it appeals to the faithful.

Also, as a reminder, we celebrate the Holy Mass in Spanish every Sunday at 5:00 pm.


