

## **MEDICATION PROCEDURE**

Please note the regulations regarding Benadryl, Advil, Motrin, Alleve, etc. Please read the following carefully so we may properly tend to your child's needs.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS: Must be brought in by the parent in the <u>original</u> pharmacy bottle with your child's name, the name of the medication, the date it was <u>filled</u>, and the dose and frequency of the medication. Medications can only be given on the written order of the doctor prescribing it.

NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION: The school nurse is permitted to administer Tylenol, antacids, and lozenges with <u>parent's written permission</u> and at the discretion of the nurse. ALL OTHER MEDICATIONS (INCLUDING BENADRYL, ADVIL, MOTRIN, ALLEVE, EYE DROPS, MEDICATED CREAMS, ETC.) REQUIRE A PHYSICIAN'S SIGNATURE.
