Reflecting on God's Word

JUST HAVE FAITH Jairus' daughter is the child of an important, privileged man, who publicly seeks out Jesus and loudly proclaims—and demonstrates—his faith, “falling at Jesus’ feet and pleading earnestly with him” (5:22–23). The anonymous woman virtually “sneaks up behind” Jesus and, though clearly filled with faith, keeps that faith to herself until Jesus draws “the whole truth” out of her after her cure (5:27–28, 33). All the more impressive, then, that Jesus delays his healing of the seemingly “more important” and younger woman for the unknown, truly marginalized older woman. Returning to the “domestic church,” so to speak, of Jairus’ house from the public setting of the older woman’s cure, Mark tells us that Jairus’ daughter has died. In the face of a hopelessness even more definitive than that of the hemorrhaging woman, people tell Jairus “why trouble the teacher any longer?” (5:35). But Jesus does not consider his response to Jairus’ faith hopeless or a bother: “Do not be afraid; just have faith” (5:36). Despite death’s apparent triumph at Jairus’ home, Jesus grasps the child’s hand—even though the law prohibited touching the dead—and bids her, “*Talitha kum*—Little girl, I say to you, arise!” (5:41).

WHY BOTHER? So Mark seems to be asking us: Like Jairus on his way home or like the woman after twelve years, will we wonder, why bother? Or keep walking in faith with Jesus? Is a silent touch of Jesus’ garment—a quiet prayer of faith—enough for us? In the face of apparent hopelessness, will we choose faith over despair despite the ridicule of the crowd, remembering that Jesus has grasped us by the hand in baptism and commanded us to rise? Note the Gospel’s ending: after bidding Jairus’ daughter rise, Jesus commands that she be given something to eat (5:43). So, too, Jesus invites us now to feast at his eucharistic sacrifice and banquet!

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Reflexionemos sobre la Palabra de Dios

SÓLO TEN FE Jairo tiene una hija, él es un hombre importante y privilegiado quien busca públicamente a Jesús, proclama intensamente y demuestra su fe “cayendo a los pies de Jesús y suplicándole de todo corazón” (5:22-23). La mujer anónima prácticamente “se acerca a hurtadillas” a Jesús y, aunque evidentemente tiene fe, se guarda esa fe hasta que Jesús le saca “toda la verdad” después de que ella es curada (5:27-28, 33). Así pues, resulta aún más impresionante que Jesús retrase la curación de quien parece ser la mujer joven y “más importante” por la desconocida y sinceramente, por la mujer mayor y marginada. Volviendo a la “iglesia doméstica”, por así decirlo, siendo la casa de Jairo el lugar público donde ocurrió la curación de la mujer mayor, Marcos nos dice que la hija de Jairo murió. Ante esta desesperanza aún más definitiva que la de la mujer hemorroisa, la gente le dice a Jairo “¿para qué molestas más al maestro?” (5:35). Pero Jesús no considera que su respuesta a la fe de Jairo sea desesperanzadora o molesta: “No tengas miedo, solo ten fe” (5:36). A pesar del aparente triunfo de la muerte en la casa de Jairo, Jesús toma la mano de la niña -aunque la ley prohibía tocar a los muertos- y le dice: “*talitha kum*” (que significa: Niña, a ti te hablo, levántate).

¿PARA QUÉ MOLESTARSE? Así parece que Marcos nos está preguntando: como Jairo en su camino a su casa o como la mujer hemorroisa después de doce años, nos preguntaremos: ¿para qué molestarnos? ¿O seguiremos caminando con fe en Jesús? ¿Será suficiente -una oración íntima con fe- con tocar sigilosamente el manto de Jesús? Ante la aparente desesperanza, ¿elegiremos la fe en lugar de la desesperación a pesar de las burlas de la multitud, recordando que Jesús nos ha tomado de la mano en el bautismo y nos ha ordenado que nos levantemos? Pon atención en el final del Evangelio, después de ordenar a la hija de Jairo que se levante, Jesús les ordena que le den de comer (5:43). Así también, Jesús nos invita ahora a festejar en su banquete y sacrificio eucarístico.

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INTENTIONAL DISCIPLES - ICONS OF GOD

“...as a matter of equality your abundance at the present time should supply their want, so that their abundance may supply your want, that there may be equality.” 2 CORINTHIANS 8:14

One of the tenants of living a grateful and generous lifestyle is giving without expecting anything in return. It is important that we not only grow, nurture and share our gifts; but that we also teach our children and encourage others to do the same. This is the communal aspect of our Catholic faith. We are the “Body of Christ”. We are called to be dependent on each other and not live in isolation.

S.O.S – Surveying Our Stewardship

In last Sunday's Gospel Jesus calms the seas but rebukes the disciples in the boat by saying "**Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?**" A traditional image of the Church is one of a boat and the "boat" that is St. Cyril of Alexandria has been tossed and damaged in the storms of the pandemic. With that storm seemingly dying down we must now assess the damages that have been inflicted on our "parish boat" and strategically determine what is needed as we move forward into a still uncertain future.

We will move forward with an **urgent concern**, not terrified, but deeply concerned. The financial damage that we are aware of above the waterline has already in some ways wreaked havoc on our ship of faith. We have already cut expenses, reduced staff and salaries and are facing more cuts. All of this will have an impact on the programs and services we can continue to provide to our parishioners.

What can you do? **Be** Vigilant in Your Prayers; **Be** Attentive to the Homilies; **Be** Ready to Embrace Some Sacrificial Giving from your household. Stewardship requires action. When we stand before God and He asks what we have done to support the mission of the Church, how will we respond?

S.O.S – Inspeccionando Nuestra Corresponsabilidad

En el evangelio del domingo pasado, Jesús calma los mares pero reprende a los discípulos en la barca diciendo: "**¿Por qué están aterrorizados? ¿Aún no tienes fe?**" Una imagen tradicional de la Iglesia es la de un barco. El "barco" que es San Cirilo de Alejandría ha sido arrojado y dañado en las tormentas de la pandemia. Con esa tormenta aparentemente amainando, ahora debemos evaluar los daños que se han infligido en nuestro "barco parroquial" y determinar estratégicamente lo que se necesita a medida que avanzamos hacia un futuro aún incierto.

Avanzaremos con una **inquietud urgente**, no aterrorizada, sino profundamente preocupada. El daño financiero del que somos conscientes por encima de la línea de flotación ya ha causado estragos en nuestro barco de la fe. Ya hemos recortado gastos, reducido personal y salarios y nos enfrentamos a más recortes. Todo esto tendrá un impacto en los programas y servicios que podemos seguir ofreciendo a nuestros feligreses.

¿Qué puedes hacer? **Sé** vigilante en sus oraciones; **Está** atento a las homilías; **Está** preparado para aceptar algunos sacrificios en tu hogar al hacer tus donaciones. La corresponsabilidad requiere acción. Cuando nos presentemos ante Dios y Él nos pregunte qué hemos hecho para apoyar la misión de la Iglesia, ¿cómo responderemos?

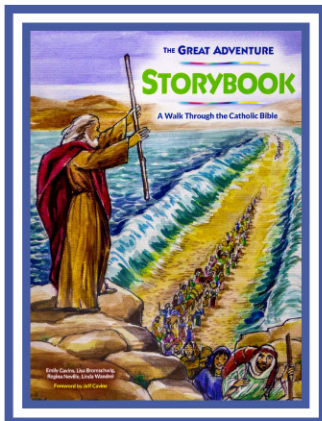

June 27 - Feast of St. Cyril of Alexandria

The patron saint of St. Cyril of Alexandria parish lived from 376 to 441 A.D. in the city of Alexandria in Egypt. He became the patriarch of that city in the year 412.

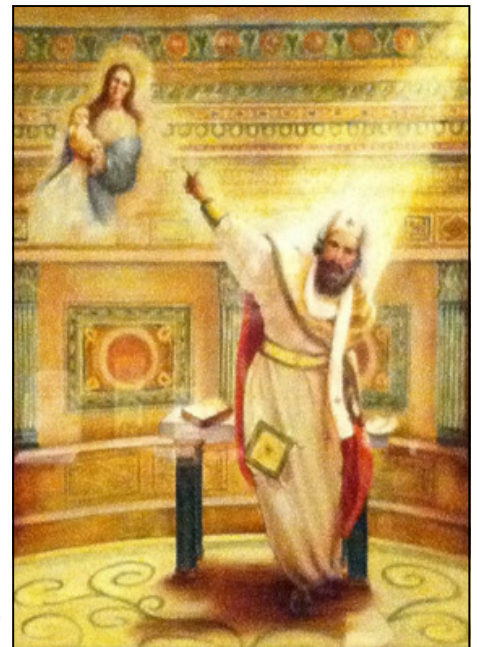
He was declared a doctor of the church in the year 1882 by Pope Leo XIII.

St. Cyril is best known for his eloquent defense of the title, "Theotokos" (God-Bearer) for the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Council of Ephesus, held in the Basilica of St. Mary, formally defined that "Theotokos" was an appropriate title for Mary.

In the year 1964, Mr. Gregory Walsh, then a member of the parish, was commissioned by Fr. E.T. Quinters to do a painting of St. Cyril.

The painting (See photo to the right captures our patron saint in one of his more representative actions. It depicts him expounding reasons why the title, "Theotokos" is a theologically sound one for the Virgin.

In the words of the artist: *"He is depicted acting impulsively, for that was his nature. The light of the Holy Spirit descends upon him, and illuminates the Basilica. The patriarch of Alexandria has swirled around and dramatically points heavenward as he implores the assembled bishops to accept the dogma. His notes fall to the floor, and his Gospel Codex perches perilously close to the edge of the altar."*

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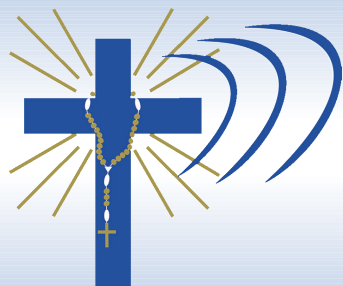
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
