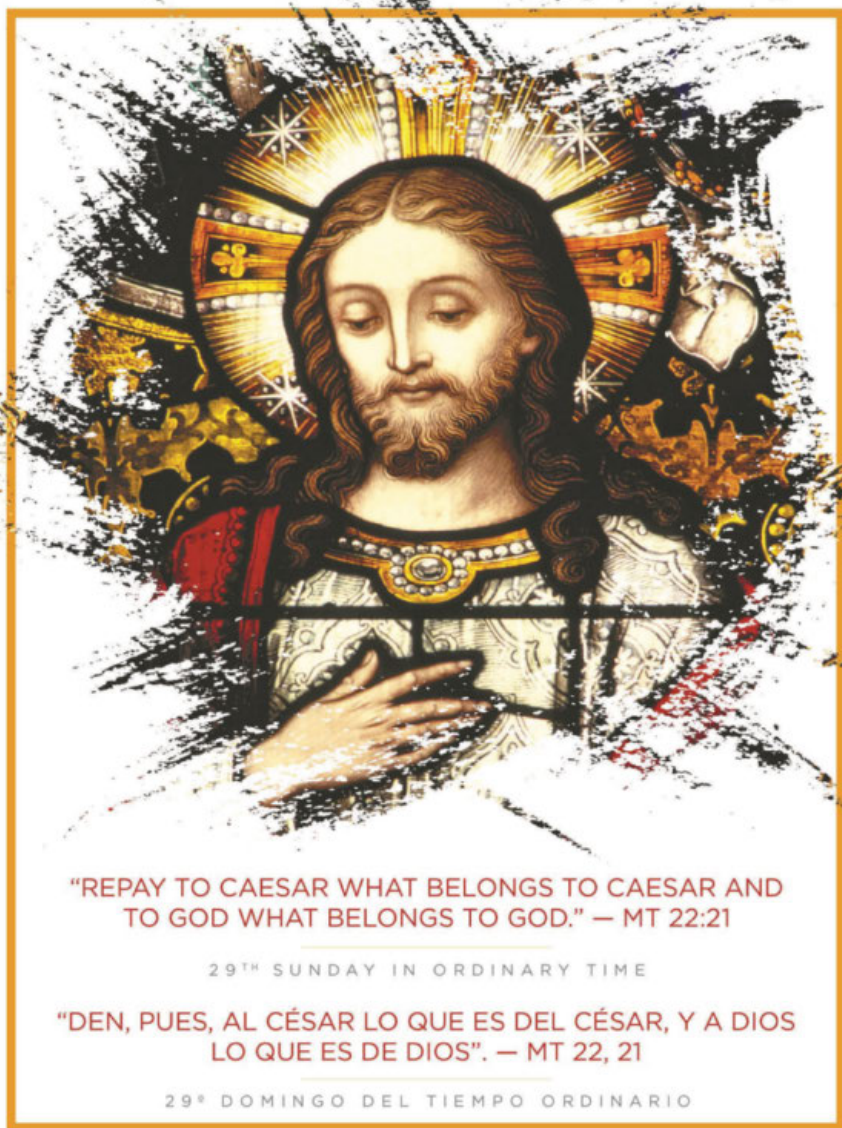

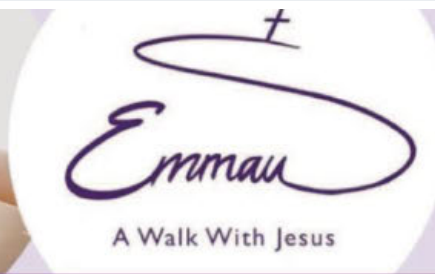

The Eucharist and the Mass - Part 5

Excerpts from "This is My Body" (Bishop Barron) and Lectio: Eucharist (Brant Pitre)

Chapter 3 - "If it's a Symbol, to Hell with it" - The Real Presence

Bishop Barron first explores Jesus' Bread of Life Discourse in John 6. The discourse can be divided into two parts, John 6:35-47 and John 6:48-58. Each section begins with the phrase "**I am the bread of life.**" It's helpful to read Chapter 6, beginning with the Feeding of the Five Thousand from five loaves and two fish. Verses 1 through 34 provide the background and setting.

The first part of the discourse "uses the miracle of manna [during the Exodus] to communicate the importance of belief (**pisteuo**) and faith (**pistis**) in Jesus' divinity. Just as the manna came down from heaven, Jesus the divine Son of God also "came down from heaven." Faith in Jesus' divinity is foundational to belief in the Eucharist, as no mere man can offer his flesh and blood as food and drink." (**Lectio: Eucharist: Dr. Brant Pitre**)

The second part of the Bread of Life discourse uses the manna as a type of the Eucharist, and emphasizes eating.

Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats[s] my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day." John 6:53-54

Bishop Barron says: "Behind the English term "eat" in this sentence is not the Greek word we would expect, **phagein**, which means to eat in the ordinary sense. The term that is used is **trogein**, which was typically employed to communicate the manner in which animals consume their food; it might be rendered as "gnaw" or "munch" in English. Thus, if they were bothered by the gross animalistic overtones of what he had said, he purposely bothered them further. And in case they still missed his meaning, he added, "For my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink" (John 6:55). (**Barron, page-74**)

The Bread of Life discourse ... proves a difficult teaching not only for Jesus' audience, but even for his disciples. Many murmur, and St. John records their thoughts: "This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?" (John 6:60). Even today the Catholic Church's teaching on the Eucharist can prove a stumbling block to some. (**Lectio: Eucharist: Dr. Brant Pitre**)

In Session 7 of Lectio: Eucharist with Dr. Brant Pitre, his examination of The Bread Of Life discourse reveals both an underlying harmony and a profound depth for understanding this consistent teaching that reaches back through the centuries to Jesus' teaching at Capernaum in John 6 and his words at the Last Supper. We recommend this excellent program.

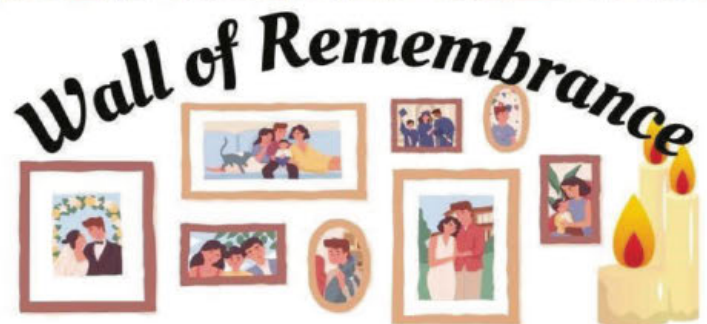
