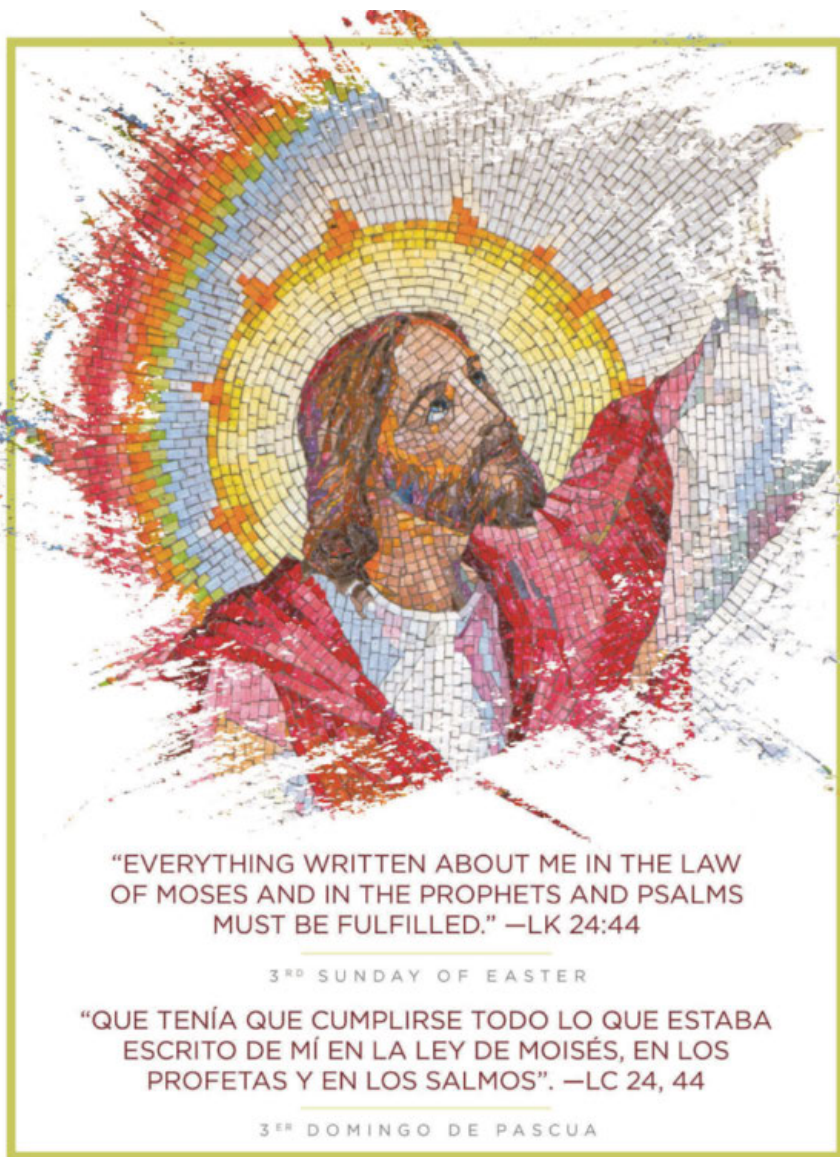

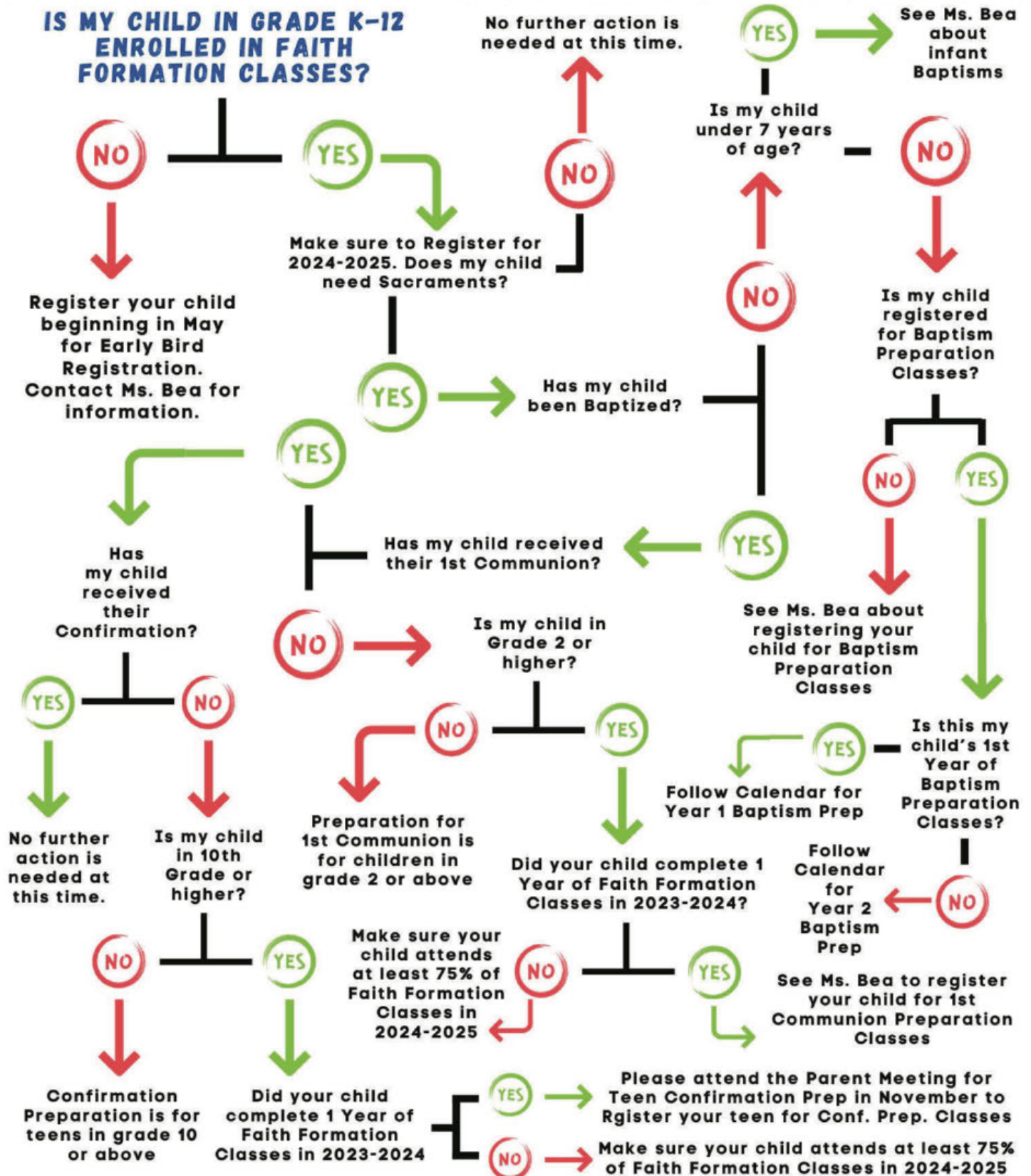

And it happened that while they were conversing and debating, Jesus himself drew near and walked with them, **but their eyes were prevented from recognizing him.**" Luke 24:13-16*

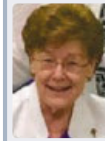

A Catholic parish is the single most important part of our Catholic Church. This is where we continue the mission of Jesus Christ. Registering in a parish is a declaration of your desire to be part of a Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of that specific parish.

Please note that parish and diocesan leadership will not share the registration information with any governmental or law enforcement agency. The registration process is completely confidential.

- In times of joy and in times of struggle, it is comforting to have the support of a faith family.
- It is a commitment to practice your faith.
- Being included in the demographics of the parish helps in the planning for the needs of the parish.
- Gives the parish a way to connect with you.
- Will facilitate and help complete the registration process for religious education instruction and Sacramental preparation

Desafortunadamente, es común que cuando alguien necesita una carta de buena reputación de la parroquia, no puede obtenerla debido a que no está registrado!


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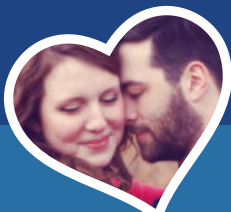
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
