Parish Council

How does a pastoral council operate?

A council meets once a month with the pastor to consider pastoral issues. It listens carefully to the concerns of the pastor, the parish staff, and others involved in the life of the parish. Through prayer and discernment, it searches for the guidance of the Holy Spirit to make recommendations to the pastor through consensus. A counselor position usually requires a couple of weekly hours to follow up on meeting agreements. Also, the council may have an annual retreat for prayer and reflection. Regular attendance at meetings is critical.

If you think you may be called to serve your community from the pastoral council or you are just interested in knowing more about it, we invite you to the information meeting. Saturday morning, November 2, at 9 AM.
