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San José Sanchez del Río - Introduction



My dear brothers and sisters:

Have you noticed the latest addition to the wall of the Narthex in Church? It contains a couple of pictures of St. Jose Sanchez del Rio as well as a letter of authentication for a relic of the saint that has been gifted to St. Cyril of Alexandria Parish. We are very blessed to have a First Class Relic (a small piece of the clavicle bone) of this beloved teenage martyr for veneration here in our parish. (I will write more about the veneration of relics in the following weeks.) The Catholic Church celebrates the Feast Day of St. Jose Sanchez del Rio on February 10, and we will be having a series of events in celebration of this beloved martyr here in our parish occurring February 7-10. Please mark your calendar and plan on participating in this special celebration. For the next couple of weeks, I will be writing more information about the importance of this event.

I would like to begin today by introducing the life of the beloved martyr St. Jose Sanchez del Rio. He was only 14 years old when he was martyred by the Mexican Army for his refusal to renounce his Catholic Faith in Jesus Christ the King. He was one of many martyrs who died during the "Cristero War" in Mexico between August 3, 1926 to June 21, 1929. (I will write more about this war in the following weeks.)

Jose Sanchez del Rio was born on March 28, 1913 in Michoacan Mexico. José was third of seven children born to Macario Sanchez and Maria del Rio, ranchers living in Sahuayo, Michoacan. They were a very faithful Catholic Family. As a young child, St. José learned to pray the rosary daily and he enjoyed attending Holy Hours with the Blessed Sacrament. He was very devout in his Catholic Faith and encouraged other children to do the same.

St. Jose was only 12 years old when the Cristero War broke out. In 1927 while visiting the grave of a beloved Cristero martyr in Guadalajara (St. Anacleto Gonzalez), St. Jose asked for his intercession that he too might also attain the grace of martyrdom. Two of Jose's older brothers joined the war in this same year. José pleaded with his mother to be allowed to join his two older brothers with the Cristeros; however, She objected strongly to his pleas due to his young age. After many pleadings, the young José responded, "Mama, do not let me lose the opportunity to gain Heaven so easily and so soon." Hearing these powerful and courageous words, St. Jose's mother could no longer deny his request.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

¿Han notado la última incorporación a la pared del Nártex de la Iglesia? Contiene un par de imágenes de San José Sánchez del Río, así como una carta de autenticación de una reliquia del santo que ha sido donada a la Parroquia de San Cirilo de Alejandría. Somos muy bendecidos por tener una Reliquia de Primer Grado (un pequeño trozo del hueso de la clavícula) de este amado mártir adolescente para venerar en nuestra parroquia. (Escribiré más sobre la veneración de reliquias en las próximas semanas). La Iglesia Católica celebra la fiesta de San José Sánchez del Río el 10 de febrero, y tendremos una serie de eventos que se llevarán a cabo del 7 al 10 de febrero para celebrar a este amado mártir. Por favor, marque su calendario para que participe en esta celebración especial. Durante las próximas semanas, escribiré más información sobre la importancia de este evento.

Me gustaría comenzar esta semana presentando la vida del amado mártir San José Sánchez del Río. Tenía sólo 14 años cuando fue martirizado por el ejército mexicano por negarse a renunciar a su fe católica en Jesucristo Rey. Fue uno de los muchos mártires que murieron durante la "Guerra Cristera" en México del 3 de agosto de 1926 al 21 de junio de 1929. (Escribiré más sobre esta guerra en las próximas semanas).

Nacido en Michoacán, México, el 28 de marzo de 1913, José Sánchez del Río fue el tercero de siete hijos de Macario Sánchez y María del Río. Era una familia de rancheros muy católica y fiel que vivían en Sahuayo, Michoacán. De niño, San José aprendió a rezar el rosario todos los días y disfrutaba de asistir a las Horas Santas con el Santísimo Sacramento. Era un católico muy devoto y animaba a otros niños a hacer lo mismo.

San José tenía sólo 12 años cuando estalló la Guerra Cristera. En 1927, mientras visitaba la tumba de un amado mártir cristero en Guadalajara (San Anacleto González), San José pidió su intercesión para que él también pudiera alcanzar la gracia del martirio. Dos de los hermanos mayores de José se unieron a la guerra en ese mismo año. José le rogó a su madre que le permitiera unirse a sus dos hermanos mayores con los cristeros; sin embargo, ella se opuso firmemente a sus súplicas debido a su corta edad. Después de muchas súplicas, el joven José respondió: "Mamá, no me dejes perder la oportunidad de ganar el Cielo tan fácilmente y tan pronto". Al escuchar estas palabras poderosas y valientes, la madre de San José ya no pudo negar su petición.

The Commander of the Cristeros in Sahuayo also did not want the young Jose to join the ranks due to his young age; however, St. Jose convinced the Commander to allow him to take care of the horses, help with the cooking and be the flag-bearer for the army. The Commander intended to shielded young Jose from actually engaging in the battles; however, during a battle on February 6, 1928, the General's horse was shot, and young St. Jose insisted the General use his horse to continue the battle. Without a horse, Jose was captured by the federal soldiers. He was taken prisoner, and was later tortured trying to make Jose renounce Christ the King. The soles of his feet were removed by his torturers, and then he was forced to walk on salt. Even as he screamed with pain, young Jose continued to shout, "Long live Christ the King". He was then forced to walk to the cemetery and to the prepared grave where he was cut by a machete before being shot to death. His last words were "Viva Cristo Rey" ("Long Live Christ the King")

As St. Jose Sanchez del Rio was granted his desire to be martyred and joined to Jesus Christ the King in Heaven, I am praying that we may all be inspired by the example of this young martyr to truly live our lives for God's Kingdom. Long Live Christ the King!

El comandante de los cristeros en Sahuayo tampoco quería que el joven José se uniera a las filas debido a su corta edad. San José convenció al comandante para que le permitiera cuidar los caballos, ayudar con la cocina y ser el abanderado del ejército. El comandante tenía la intención de proteger al joven José de participar realmente en las batallas; sin embargo, durante una batalla el 6 de febrero de 1928, el caballo del general recibió un disparo. El joven San José insistió en que el general usara su caballo para continuar la batalla. Sin caballo, José fue capturado por los soldados federales. Fue hecho prisionero y, posteriormente, torturado en un intento de hacer que José renunciara a Cristo Rey. Los torturadores le quitaron las plantas de los pies y lo obligaron a caminar sobre sal. Incluso mientras gritaba de dolor, el joven José siguió gritando: "Viva Cristo Rey". Luego lo obligaron a caminar hasta el cementerio a una tumba preparada, donde lo cortaron con un machete antes de matarlo a tiros. Sus últimas palabras fueron "Viva Cristo Rey".

Como a San José Sánchez del Río se le concedió su deseo de ser martirizado y unirse a Jesucristo Rey en el Cielo, estoy rezando para que todos podamos ser inspirados por el ejemplo de este joven mártir para vivir verdaderamente nuestras vidas para el Reino de Dios. ¡Viva Cristo Rey!

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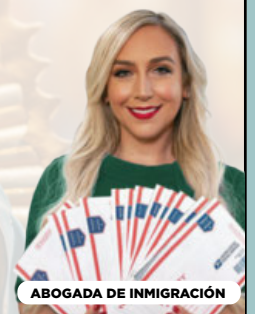
