San José Sanchez del Río - Veneration of Relics



My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

In last week's bulletin, I wrote about the life of the young martyr, St. Jose Luis Sanchez del Río, and how this parish was gifted with a special relic of this beloved saint. The framed display in the Narthex of the Church includes the original letter of authenticity from Bishop Javier Navarro Rodriguez of the diocese of Zamora in Mexico. The translation of the letter is as follows:

I attest, through this letter, that the "ex ossibus" relic of the martyr José Sánchez del Río is a particle taken from the authentic relics (clavicle) that are kept in the parish church of Santiago Apostol in Sahuayo, Michoacán. It has been donated to St. Cyril of Alexandria Catholic Church Parish in Houston, Texas at the request of the Pastor Rev. Christopher D. Shackelford.

A Holy Relic is a fragment of a person's body, or from some personal object associated with a sacred person, that has been preserved as worthy of veneration. The words "Ex ossibus" is a Latin phrase meaning "from the bone". This precious gift of a fragment of the clavicle bone of St. Jose is a truly a Blessed treasure for our parish.

So why does the Catholic Church place an emphasis on the veneration of holy relics? Holy Relics are important in Christian history because they help strengthen the faithful's devotion to the saints by highlighting their sacrifices and heroic deeds. St. Paul writes, "As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ" (1 Cor.12:12). Scripture teaches that God acts through relics, especially in terms of healing. Some example of this can be found in 2 Kings 13:20-21 where the corpse of a man comes back to life after being touched with the bones of the prophet Elisha. We also find the story of the woman healed of her hemorrhage simply by touching the hem of Jesus' cloak (Matthew 9:20-22). In each of these instances God has brought about a healing using a material object. The vehicle for the healing was the touching of that object. God is the actual source of the healing, but the relics are a means through which God acts. Holy relics do not contain any power apart from God's grace. From the first century of Christianity, it was common practice to offer Mass over the grave of martyrs. This was a powerful symbol of the Church being truly one body with all the Saints and Martyrs in Heaven. In many Catholic Churches, there is a holy relic embedded inside the consecrated altar itself.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En el boletín de la semana pasada, escribí sobre la vida del joven mártir, San José Luis Sánchez del Río, y cómo esta parroquia recibió el regalo de una reliquia especial de este amado santo. La exhibición enmarcada en el Nártex de la Iglesia incluye la carta original de autenticidad del Obispo Javier Navarro Rodríguez de la diócesis de Zamora en México:

Day fe, por medio de esta carta, de que la reliquia "ex ossibus" del mártir José Sánchez del Río es una partícula tomada de las auténticas reliquias (clavícula) que se custodian en la Iglesia parroquial de Santiago Apóstol en Sahuayo, Michoacán. Ha sido donada a la Parroquia de. St. Cyril of Alexandria Catholic Church de Houston, Texas a petición del Sr. Cura Christopher D. Shackelford.

Una Reliquia Sagrada es un fragmento del cuerpo de una persona, o de algún objeto personal asociado con una persona sagrada, que se ha conservado como digno de veneración. Las palabras "Ex ossibus" son una frase latina que significa "del hueso". Este precioso obsequio de un fragmento de la clavícula de San José es un verdadero tesoro bendito para nuestra parroquia.

Entonces, ¿por qué la Iglesia Católica pone énfasis en la veneración de las reliquias sagradas? Las reliquias sagradas son importantes en la historia cristiana porque ayudan a fortalecer la devoción de los fieles a los santos al resaltar sus sacrificios y hazañas heroicas. San Pablo escribe: "Así como el cuerpo es uno aunque tiene muchos miembros, y todos los miembros del cuerpo, aunque muchos, son un solo cuerpo, así también Cristo" (1 Cor. 12:12). Las Escrituras enseñan que Dios actúa a través de las reliquias, especialmente en términos de curación. Un ejemplo de esto se puede encontrar en 2 Reyes 13:20-21, donde el cadáver de un hombre vuelve a la vida después de ser tocado por los huesos del profeta Eliseo. También encontramos la historia de la mujer que fue curada de su hemorragia simplemente al tocar el borde del manto de Jesús (Mateo 9:20-22). En cada uno de estos casos, Dios ha realizado una curación utilizando un objeto material. El vehículo para la curación fue el contacto con ese objeto. Dios es la fuente real de la curación, pero las reliquias son un medio a través del cual Dios actúa. Las reliquias sagradas no contienen ningún poder aparte de la gracia de Dios. Desde el primer siglo del cristianismo, era una práctica común ofrecer la misa sobre la tumba de los mártires. Este era un símbolo poderoso de que la Iglesia era verdaderamente un solo cuerpo con todos los santos y mártires en el cielo. En muchas iglesias católicas, hay una reliquia sagrada incrustada dentro del altar consagrado.

There are three classifications for relics. The "ex ossibus" relic of St. Jose is referred to as a First-class relic. Second-class relics are something that a saint personally owned, such as a personal garment or book. Third class relics are those items that a saint touched or that have been touched to a first, second, or another third -class relic of a saint. During the veneration of a First-Class relic, such as that of St. Jose Luis Sanchez del Rio, any item that is touched to this relic would become a third-class relic. We have ordered some special Holy Cards of St. Jose in both English and in Spanish so that those who are interested in receiving them will be able to touch them to this First-class relic and thereby have a Third-Class relic of this Beloved martyr to return to their home.

Let us pray that through the intercession of St. Jose Sanchez del Rio, our families, especially our youth, may have a greater passion for serving God and preparing for the coming of His Kingdom. Viva Cristo Rey! Long Live Christ the King!
