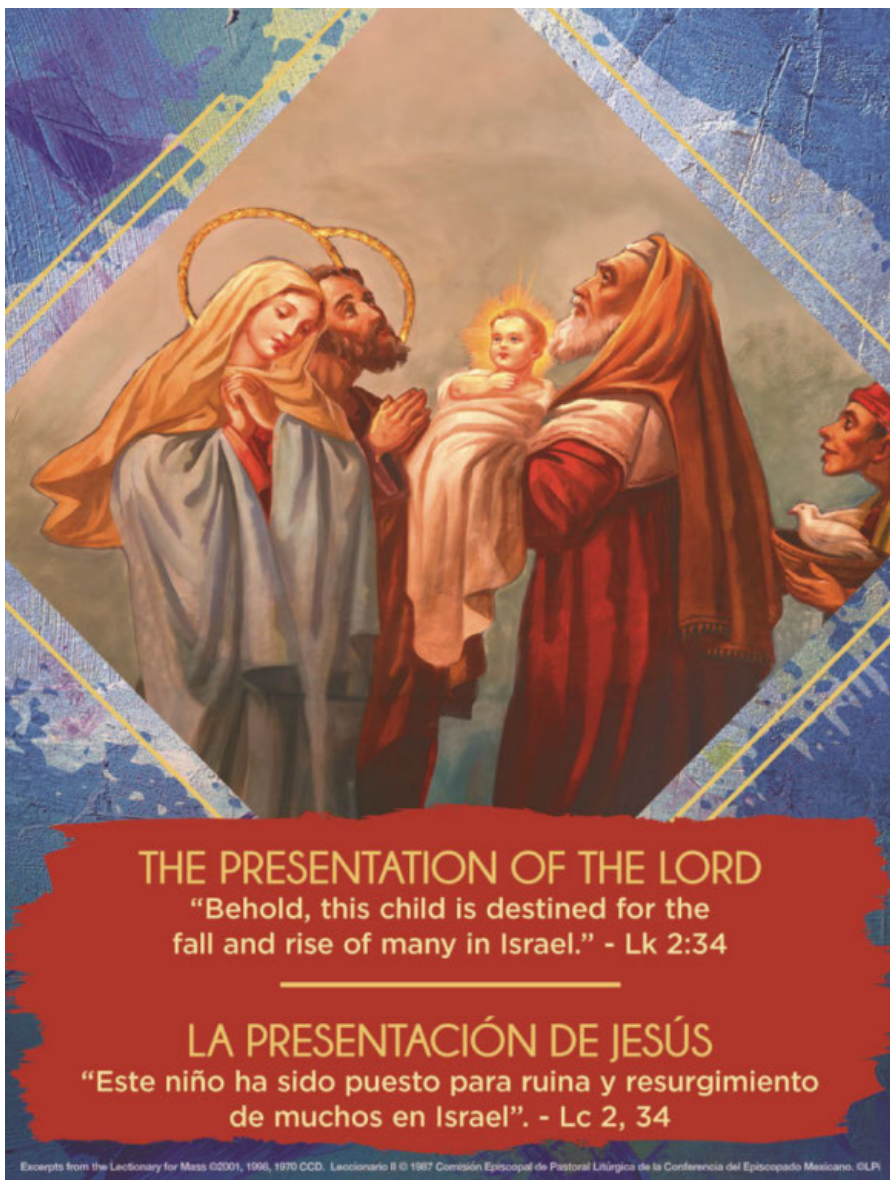

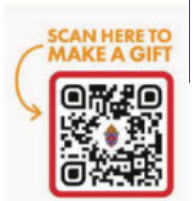

San José Sanchez del Río



My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

As I continue this series on the Martyrdom of St. Jose Sanchez del Rio, I would like to write a little more about the context of his death during the “Cristero War” also known as the “Cristero Rebellion”. This primarily rural uprising by the faithful Catholics in North-Central Mexico was in response to the implementation of the secularist and anticlerical articles of the 1917 Mexican Constitution by the Mexican President Plutarco Elias Calles. President Calles sought to strictly enforce Article 130 of the 1917 Constitution to limit the power of the Catholic Church in Mexico and to suppress popular religiosity. All Catholic Bishops and Priests were exiled from Mexico, and some of them even came to Texas during this period. Those who remained to celebrate the sacraments for the faithful were executed if discovered. Between August 3, 1926 until June 21, 1929, over one hundred thousand men, women (and even some children) of the

Catholic Laity along with Catholic Clergy were martyred for defending the practice of their Catholic Faith. All Catholic Churches were closed down, and no Catholic Ceremonies or Sacraments were allowed to be celebrated in Mexico.

The rural uprisings of the Cristero Fighters against the Mexican Troops were supported the by the Catholic Church Heirarchy (from their exile) as well as by urban Catholic supporters and even the Catholic Knights of Columbus from the United States. The Mexican army received support from the Mexican government as well as from the United States Government. The Ku Klux Klan responded by funding the Mexican government, helping it fight against the Catholic Church. With the encouragement of the Knights of Columbus, the American Ambassador Dwight Morrow brokered negotiations between Calles (and the Mexican government) and the Catholic Church. After the Mexican government made some concessions, the Church withdrew its support for the Cristero fighters, and the conflict officially ended in June 1929.

Although the “Cristero War” officially ended in 1929, the Mexican government continued to persecute and even kill more Catholics for many years that followed. The Cristero War Rebellion was a major event in the struggle between the Church and State in Mexico going back to the “War of Reform” in the 19th Century. The Cristero War was also the last major peasant uprising in Mexico after the end of the military phase of the Mexican Revolution of 1920.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Al continuar esta serie sobre el martirio de San José Sánchez del Río, me gustaría escribir un poco más sobre el contexto de su muerte durante la “Guerra Cristera”, también conocida como la “Rebelión Cristera”. Esta insurrección principalmente rural de los fieles católicos en el centro-norte de México fue en respuesta a la implementación de los artículos secularistas y anticlericales de la Constitución mexicana de 1917 por parte del presidente mexicano Plutarco Elías Calles. El presidente Calles buscó aplicar estrictamente el artículo 130 de la Constitución de 1917 para limitar el poder de la Iglesia Católica en México y suprimir la religiosidad popular. Todos los obispos y sacerdotes católicos fueron exiliados de México, y algunos de ellos incluso llegaron a Texas durante este período. Aquellos que se quedaron para celebrar los sacramentos para los fieles fueron ejecutados si eran descubiertos. Entre el 3 de agosto de 1926 y el 21 de junio de 1929, más de cien mil hombres, mujeres (e incluso algunos niños) del laicado católico, junto con el clero católico, fueron martirizados por defender la práctica de su fe católica. Todas las iglesias católicas fueron clausuradas y no se permitió la celebración de ceremonias o sacramentos católicos en México.

Las insurrecciones rurales de los combatientes cristeros contra las tropas mexicanas fueron apoyados por la jerarquía de la Iglesia católica (desde su exilio), así como por partidarios católicos urbanos e incluso por los Caballeros de Colón católicos de los Estados Unidos. El ejército mexicano recibió apoyo del gobierno mexicano, así como del gobierno de los Estados Unidos. El Ku Klux Klan respondió financiando al gobierno mexicano, ayudándolo a luchar contra la Iglesia católica. Con el apoyo de los Caballeros de Colón, el embajador estadounidense Dwight Morrow negoció las negociaciones entre Calles (y el gobierno mexicano) y la Iglesia católica. Después de que el gobierno mexicano hiciera algunas concesiones, la Iglesia retiró su apoyo a los combatientes cristeros y el conflicto terminó oficialmente en junio de 1929.

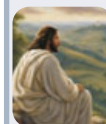
