NEW AUXILIARY BISHOP OF DALLAS NAMED

On Wednesday, Pope Francis announced in Rome that Dallas priest Monsignor John Gregory Kelly has been named a bishop and will serve as an auxiliary or assistant bishop for the Dallas diocese. He has been a priest in the Dallas diocese for nearly 34 years. He will be ordained as a bishop on February 11, 2016 at 2:00 PM at the Cathedral Shrine of the Virgin Guadalupe in Dallas and will join Bishop Farrell and Auxiliary Bishop Deshotel in ministering to an evergrowing flock of 1.3 million Catholics in the Diocese of Dallas.


