Spes Gregis Seminarian Dinner

Raises \$350,000 for Student Center

A crowd of 750 gathered at the Hilton Anatole in Dallas for Holy Trinity Seminary's fundraising event for a much-needed student center. Monsignor Francis Malone, a 1977 alumnus and currently pastor of Christ the King parish in Little Rock, AR, was the keynote speaker. Monsignor explained his parish's focus on vocations through Eucharistic adoration and an increased presence in schools and how this has created an effective culture of vocations with eleven vocations just from his parish. Along with the dinner's financial success, an important outcome was bringing together for one night the seminary community with bishops, priests, alumni, parents, benefactors and supporters, and volunteers to give thanks for the gift of priesthood and how Holy Trinity Seminary is preparing the next generation of priests eager and committed to serve Christ in his people.
