# <u>March Project:</u> Right to Life Baby Shower

The March service project is the annual Baby Shower benefitting White Rose and Birth Choice pregnancy crisis centers. This is a joint effort between the St. Mark Respect Life Club and Knights of Columbus Council 6065. It will be held at school on Wednesday, March 30. Preschool and elementary students donate needed baby items. Middle school students donate change during lunch periods. See below for specifics.

#### Preschool & Elementary Students:

Students will donate needed baby items. Click here for more information about the collection, and the needs list. If necessary, donations may be brought to the school between March 21-29, however, it is preferred that they be dropped off to RLC volunteers who will be present at all morning carpool lines on March 30.

#### Middle School Students:

Students will donate change during their lunch periods between March 14-24. Change should be deposited into the container at the front of the cafeteria labeled with the student's grade level (6th, 7th, 8th). The containers are quite large, so it will take the entire grade to fill them up!

Change should be placed in a baggie and shown to the student's religion teacher before depositing into the container (so the student gets credit for the March service project).

The grade that fills their container first wins a free dress day on March 30 and ice cream during lunch. If the other grades fill their containers, they will also get ice cream at lunch on March 30.

The money collected will be used to purchase car seats and/or cribs for the centers.


