new building" are nice, but if you don't have excellent teachers and staff supporting students, nothing works.

Both Ms. Steinkirchner and I perform continuous classroom observations, so we truly experience what your children experience on an ongoing basis. During my many years in education, I have worked with numerous master teachers, and I can tell you without the slightest hesitation that St. Mark teachers exceed that standard every day. They could teach in a *shack* and students would still rise to excellence. The level of thought, planning, and execution that they perform in their daily lessons is exemplary. And it's not just us who recognize this fact.

Over the years, our teachers and staff members have been honored on the local, state and national levels. Many of our teachers are sought after for tasks such as rewriting Diocesan curriculum. Other schools send their teachers to St. Mark so they can observe masterful educators in action. In just the past two years, we have had requests for four teachers to present at national-level conferences on technology, as well as on engaging lessons. And I myself was asked by our Superintendent to lead the Diocesan S.T.E.M. initiative this past year. Our staff members have received The Catholic Foundation's Work of Heart Award 44 times since it began in 2005. Second grade teacher, Ms. Carolyn Eisele, was named Diocesan Teacher of the Year in 2016. Our teachers are all state-certified, many with specialized certifications, and more than one-third hold advanced degrees. They come to St. Mark and stay at St. Mark. Not all schools can claim such a low teacher turnover rate, which is something to be immensely proud of. This speaks directly to the positive and professional environment that St. Mark fosters.

Our Students are Motivated to Excel in All Areas

Two National Blue Ribbon Awards and a rare third Blue Ribbon qualification in recent years confirm that our students consistently score in the top 15% in the nation on standardized tests, which means that classroom lessons are meeting their mark. Beyond the classroom, students who participate in our enrichment and extra-curricular programs constantly EXCEL. These include Spelling Bee, History Bee, Geography Bee, Quiz Bowl, PSIA, Robotics, Catholic Math League, Math Counts, Youth In Government, and the Diocesan Speech Tournament, just to name a few. In most competitions, St. Mark students typically earn a spot (or spots) on the winners' podium. And we're not just competing against other Catholic schools; many times we are competing against non-Catholic private schools and we continue to succeed. In addition, the number of our students who qualify

ENROLLMENT TIPS

Re-enrollment for the 2017-18 school year runs through Friday, February 17. Click the link on the homepage of the school website for complete instructions.

Registration Fee

You will be prompted to pay the registration fee at the end of the enrollment form. Unlike prior years, the fee payment is embedded into the form and you cannot submit the form without paying the fee. Please do not pay the fee via the school website as it will not link to the enrollment form in RenWeb.

Additionally, please be sure to only click "submit payment" once. If you double-click too quickly, the fee will be charged twice. If this happens, please contact the school office.

Late Enrollments

The enrollment form is hard-coded so that if you miss the enrollment cut-off date of Friday, February 17, 2017, then you will be charged the \$100 late fee. If you have extenuating circumstances preventing you from enrolling by the cut-off date, please contact the school office.




