PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



While all of these programs are designed to instill our Catholic values within our students, the real reward that we see (and we hope you see at home), is when students take what they've learned and put it into action. If you would like to volunteer on Field Day, there is still time pay your HSA dues and become Safe Environment cleared. Please contact <u>Jill Dourty</u>.


