

SCHOOL PICTURE ORDERS

Lifetouch school picture proofs were sent home with your child on October 2. Picture orders are due back in the school office by October 13. You may order school pictures in one of two ways:

- *Place your order online through the Lifetouch website. Instructions are included with the proof. If you order online, there is no need to return the proof/order form to the school.
- *Complete the order form included with the proof. Send it, along with payment, to the school office. If paying by check, please make it out to "Lifetouch" and include your child's name on the memo line.

If you are not happy with your child's school picture, retakes will take place on October 23. If your child will participate in retakes, please email the teacher by October 22. This will insure that your child will be sent to the photographer on retake day.

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL LINES

Our afternoon dismissal lines are becoming an increasing safety concern. We are seeing that many cars do not have signs to identify the student(s) to be picked up.

Last request: All cars must have a sign displayed in the front windshield <u>that includes the child(ren) name(s)</u> written in letters at least 2 inches tall in bold, black <u>marker</u>. This includes daycares.


Welcome to the St. Mark Community Prayer Team! It is our goal to bring the St. Mark


