

COMMUNITY PRAYER TEAM



Welcome to the St. Mark Community Prayer Team! It is our goal to bring the St. Mark community closer to Christ and each other. There will be many

*Prayer Walks: We will conduct Prayer Walks on the first Friday of each month and hope you can join us. The next one will take place December 6.

As the temperatures begin to drop, please be sure your child is properly dressed for the cold weather, including coats/hats/gloves. Classes can potentially walk outside between buildings during transition times, emergency drills can take students outside, students are outside during dismissal, and daily recess takes place outside as long as the temperature is above 32 degrees (reference page 46 of the Parent Student Handbook).

School uniform options include long sleeve shirts and sweaters for all students, as well as tights and knee socks for girls. Please keep in mind that uniform pieces must adhere to the guidelines that start on page 28 of the Parent Student Handbook. Non-uniform shirts, fleeces, jackets, etc. are not permitted during the school day.


