


WEEKLY SCHOOL BULLETIN: April 3, 2020

SACRAMENT & MASS UPDATES FROM FATHER MARCO



We received the following information from Father Marco this week regarding Confirmation, First Communion, and daily and Easter masses.

Regarding the sacraments in general: "The only direction we have

received from the diocese is that they are to be postponed until further notice. We are making decisions, at times day-to-day. Most things are up in the air, so we will let parents know as soon as we know more. In the meantime, we encourage students to keep praying and studying their faith formation lessons. Once we are able to provide firm dates, we will do so."

<u>Confirmation</u>: "Confirmations (since they were scheduled for April), will be postponed until there is a greater certainty that it is safe to congregate again in groups."

<u>First Communion</u>: "Regarding First Holy Communions scheduled for May, that is yet unclear, as the current guidelines only apply until April 30. However, even if the guidelines were lifted, I doubt we would go immediately into the previous normal working order. I imagine there will be a post-crisis transition back to regular things, which will likely mean no group gatherings still."

<u>Daily & Easter Masses</u>: "We are doing the best we can to provide a live-stream option for our parish. The parish now has a <u>YouTube channel</u>. We also have a <u>parish Facebook page</u> and that is often where things appear live, and then afterwards are uploaded to YouTube. We are looking at other options as well."
