





Dear St. Mark Family,

For the past 26 years, Kidventure has served families in Houston, Austin, and Dallas through the magic of summer camp and after school. It has been a pleasure to be a part of the St. Mark Family for 4 of those 26 years. As we embark on another summer of partnership with your school and community. Kidventure would like to update you on the ways we are preparing to give summer camp families the safest and best experience possible this year.

As we move into the month of May and closer to summer, we want to strive to maintain clear communication and update our communities on Kidventure's progress towards our 26th summer of camp. We understand how trying and uncertain things are right now in just about every aspect of our leves. We also understand the part we as Kidventure play in the lives of our families in supporting working parents and supporting the emotional, social, and physical health of our lads. Kids need camp, but camp needs to be a safe place first. That is our number one goal.

Preparing for Safety and Wellbeing at Camp

May has always been a busy month for Katventure as we spend much of this month organizing supplies, training staff, preparing cumculum, and gotting ready for our kids. While all those things are being done, we've made many changes in preparation for camp in the era of COVID-19. Protocols will be updated as necessity dictates. Some of the changes we are planning for are as follows:

- The increased disinfection of our camp facilities and regular sanitation of surfaces and high use areas.
- · Additional staff hired to support in cleaning, sanitizing, and caring for the overall health of camp.
- A strict health and safety policy pertaining to our staff to ensure their health and wellbeing for themselves and our campers.
- Curbside drop off and pick up limiting the entering of camp to just camp staff, campers, and authorized personnel.
- . Daily rapid temperature checks upon entering camp for all staff and campers
- Campers will operate in small groups at camp.
- · Regular hand washing breaks (probably with singing and dancing).
- Camp will be limited to onsite activities only. There will be no field trips or transportation on buses. This will limit our camp's exposure to other large group gatherings and the general public.

The Next Couple of Weeks We Will Know More

While we do have Interim Guidelines from the CDC for operating camp. Governor Abboth has not yet released guidelines specific to Texas summer camp operation. We know that the next update by Governor Abboth is scheduled for May 18th. The new guidelines will likely require some additional procedures for conducting camp. Once we understand those guidelines, we will adjust our procedures and notify our communities.
