Fact Family Friday-Create fact families out the numbers that are given. (Ex. $3+4=7$, $4+3=7$, $7-3=4$, $7-4=3$)

STEAM Saturday-Activities that focus on creativity and problem solving.

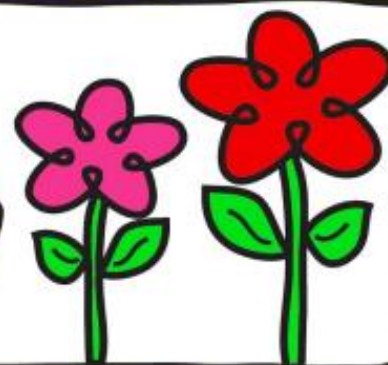
Don't forget to READ, READ, READ! Research tells us the more a student reads at home the better they will do in school.

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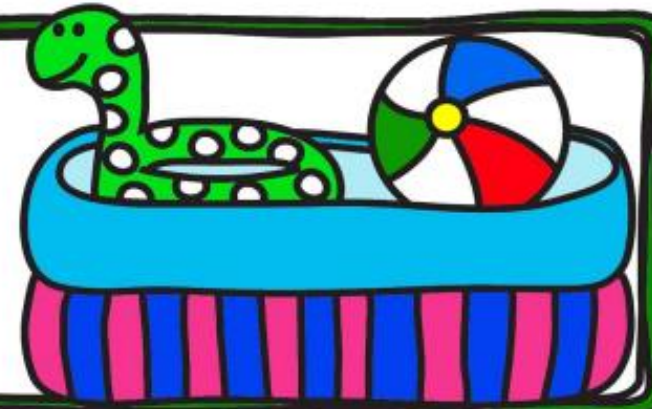


