"Kick Start" Needs for Kindergarten

These are the identified skills necessary for students to kick start the year in the right direction. Please spend time over the summer reinforcing these important skills so your child can start the new year off successfully.

Incoming KINDERGARTERNERS:

- Know full name, age, address, & phone number
- Identify and write name using initial capital letter and rest lower case
- Say alphabet, not sing
- Identification of letters and sounds
- Recognize and read simple sight words- A, and, the, I, is
- Identification of numbers 1-30
- Create AB, ABC patterns
- Concept of print materials:
 - o Where is the title?
 - o Where is the beginning of the book?
 - o Where do I begin to read (top to bottom)?
 - O When you finish a page, where do you read next?
 - o Where is the end of the book?
 - o How do the sentences flow (left to right)?
- Identify basic shapes- circle, triangle, square, rectangle, heart, star
- Understand positional words- above, below, on, over, under, etc.
- Recognize and read color words- red, yellow, orange, blue, green, purple, brown, black
- Write numbers 1-30
- Follow 2-3 step verbal directions
- Sit and listen to story/presentation for at least 10 minutes
- Can recite words that rhyme
- Can determine beginning, middle, and ending word sounds
