

"Kick Start" Needs for PK-4

These are the identified skills necessary for students to kick start the year in the right direction. Please spend time over the summer reinforcing these important skills so your child can start the new year off successfully.

Incoming PK4 Students:

- Acknowledge/respond/raise hand when their first name is called
- Identify their first name in print
- Beginning to write their first name properly- first letter capital, the rest lower case
- Follow 1-2 step verbal directions
- Ask questions when need help
- Using scissors independently
- Proper pencil grip
- Beginning to identify capital and lowercase letters of the alphabet
- Identify and beginning to write numbers 0-10
- Counting 5 or more objects using one to one correspondence
- Identify shapes- circle, triangle, square, rectangle, heart, star
- Identify colors- red, yellow, orange, blue, green, purple, brown, black
- Able to complete all restroom and dressing needs independently
