- · Attendance at a minimum of 30 Sunday Masses per year at St. Mark.

While we primarily track financial contributions for our school families, the other two aspects remain important expectations. That said, as disciples of Christ, we are called not to seek the minimum but to embrace a spirit of generosity, giving our lives more fully to Him.

As we prepare for the 2025-2026 academic year, I am excited for the opportunities ahead. I look forward to seeing our children grow in knowledge, virtue, and faith, taking steps toward becoming the servant leaders God has called them to be.
