

## SAFE ENVIRONMENT

All training/renewals must be completed before August 15, 2025, regardless of your renewal date, for you to be able to volunteer in any capacity for the 2025-2026 school year. You will have from May 2<sup>nd</sup> to August 15<sup>th</sup> to renew or be trained for the 2025-2026 school year. We are excited to welcome volunteers on campus for the 2025-2026 school year who have been cleared through the Diocesan Safe Environment program. Please view the Safe Environment procedures on how to apply for Safe Environment clearance and/or renew your cleared status. All volunteers must participate in an annual training before August 15<sup>th</sup> to volunteer during the current school year. I highly recommend that you complete this process before July 1<sup>st</sup> because the Diocese is switching to a new database on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### Safe Environment Procedures for Previously Cleared Volunteers

Step 1: Log in at <a href="http://dallas.setanet.org/obligations.php">http://dallas.setanet.org/obligations.php</a> and watch a training video.

Step 2: At the end, scroll down, and click on "Take Quiz".

#### **Safe Environment Procedures for New Volunteers**

Step 1: Complete the online screening form using the following link: <a href="https://dallas.setanet.org/screening.php">https://dallas.setanet.org/screening.php</a>
Under the location info section, please identify "St. Mark Catholic School" for location and "volunteer" for position. A background check and a reference check will then be completed. Please make sure to have the email addresses for your references on this form.

Step 2: Read the Diocese of Dallas Computer Internet Policy and the Diocese of Dallas Social Media Policy. Both documents have a signature page that needs to be signed.

Step 3: Log in at <a href="http://dallas.setanet.org/obligations.php">http://dallas.setanet.org/obligations.php</a> and watch the training video "Recognizing, Responding, and Reporting (Ministry Safe)". Forward a copy of your certificate to <a href="mailto:alison.hughes@stmcs.net">alison.hughes@stmcs.net</a>.

Step 4: Contact <u>alison.hughes@stmcs.net</u> to complete an interview.

ALL of these steps must be completed to volunteer.

If you plan on volunteering in any form at St. Mark for the 2025-2026 school year, complete this program ASAP.
