### FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



In today's Gospel reading, the rich man asks his steward to prepare an accounting of his stewardship.

two places. First, our calendar. When we look at our calendar, would people know that we are followers of Jesus? Would they know we make time for prayer each day, go to Mass, and attend faith–enriching events? Do I spend some time each week in serving other people, or the Church? The second place we might look is our checkbook. If someone looked at our checkbook would they notice charitable giving, not only to the church, but to other worthy organizations as well? Now is the time to examine and work on our stewardship efforts, before we are asked on that last day to make an account.



## **OCTOBER DEVOTION**

October is the month of the Rosary. This is primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7th. The feast was introduced by Pope St. Pius V (1504-1572) in the year 1571 to commemorate the miraculous victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The pope attributed victory more to the "arms" of the Rosary than the power of cannons and the valor of the soldiers who fought there.
