Even in the tree he might be lost in the crowd, except for one thing: Not only is Zacchaeus seeking Jesus, but Jesus is seeking him. He calls him down from the tree and invites himself to Zacchaeus' house. Jesus announces that salvation has come to Zacchaeus' house and that the Son of Man has come to SEEK and SAVE what was lost. 



### ALL SOULS MASS AT HOLY REDEEMER CEMETERY
