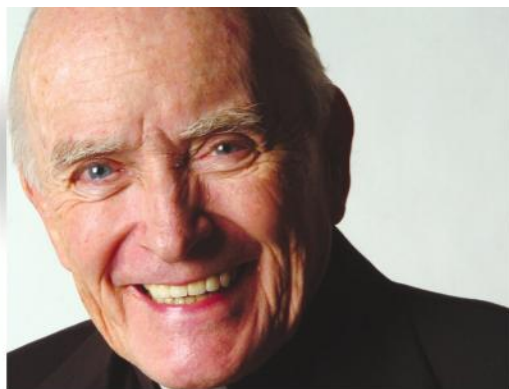

FAITH. The seven brothers in Maccabees would rather face death than renounce their faith

in the resurrection. They believe that everything comes from God and are confident that death is just the doorway to spending eternity with Him.

HOPE. In the Psalm, we proclaim "Lord, when your glory appears, my joy will be full." Our earthly life does not lead to loss and decay, but to the great hope of sharing in God's glory.

CHARITY. Paul shows us that God has first loved us and He strengthens us for our journey, that we may encourage and love others along the way. "May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God."

This week, focus on these virtues and know that the Lord has given us the tools to endure our trials on this earth, so that we may joyfully live with Him in eternity.

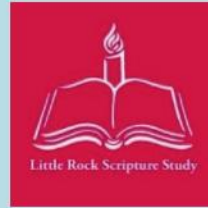

When a man joins a religious community like the Dominicans or Salesians, **he becomes a brother**. He takes vows of **poverty, chastity, and obedience**. Some brothers go on to be ordained priests. Interestingly, in the day-to-day lives of many religious communities, there isn't a pronounced hierarchical difference between priests and brothers, though of course only the priests celebrate Mass. **(St. Francis, the beloved founder of the Franciscans, was a deacon, not a priest.)** In this regard, there is a huge variety of traditions from one community to the other. Why not ask a religious man you know what the practice is in his community?
