

Sunday of Divine Mercy

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



This week's second reading from Saint Peter says, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who in His great mercy, gave us a new birth to a living hope through the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." What mercy that is!

This is Divine Mercy Sunday, which is based upon a divine revelation to a Polish nun, Sister Faustina Kowalska (1905-1938),

who kept a diary which is now regarded as a spiritual classic of the twentieth century. Based upon God's revelations, she developed an image of the Lord with the words: "Jesus, I trust in you." Saint Faustina (canonized in 2000) is also the source of the beautiful Chaplet of Divine Mercy, which is among the favorite prayers of so many. The devotion to the Divine Mercy means that we center our faith and hope in the merciful love of God, and in the desire to let His mercy flow through our hearts, minds, and souls. Saint John Paul II said, "Indeed the message [St. Faustina] brought is the appropriate and incisive answer that God wanted to offer to the questions and expectations of human beings in our time, marked by terrible tragedies." That seems even more relevant today than when it was spoken a mere 17 years ago.

Divine Mercy Sunday helps us to recall, in sorrow, that we are not worthy; and that we must strive now, and always, to be more faithful disciples of Christ. Divine Mercy Sunday helps us to recall, in joy, that the Lord, through the sacred power of the sacraments, has given us the means of spiritual growth.

Please join us this Sunday at 3:00 p.m. as we pray together the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. As a reminder, the Divine Mercy Chaplet is prayed every day at 3:00 p.m. on Catholic Radio (KATH, 910 AM.)
