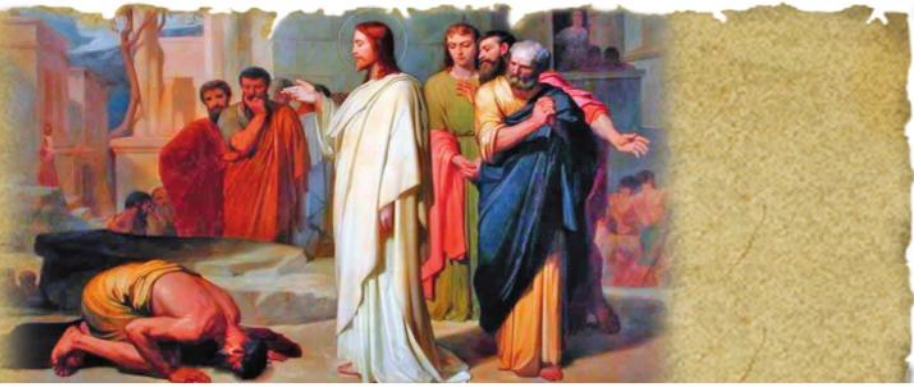

## FLU Advisory

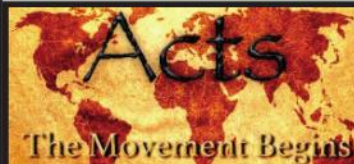
If you suspect that you have symptoms of the Flu, please refrain from receiving the Precious Blood until you have recovered. Receiving only the Precious Body is advised until you are well.
