

Bishop Burns announced last Saturday, along with Mayor Mike Rawlings of Dallas and other city and faith leaders of the Dallas area, the launch of the #BeGolden campaign. This campaign is an effort to highlight the importance of the Golden Rule: to treat others as we would like to be treated.

A particular focus of #BeGolden is immigrants and

our cities and parishes. The Golden Rule calls us to highlight the human dignity of all people, especially those who are vulnerable, and to change the conversation about them to one of respect.

Pope Francis, in his address to the US Congress in 2015, invoked the Golden Rule specifically in regard to immigrants.

"Let us remember the Golden Rule: 'Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.' This Rule points us in a clear direction. Let us treat others with the same passion and compassion with which we want to be treated. Let us seek for others the same possibilities which we seek for ourselves. Let us help others to grow, as we would like to be helped ourselves. In a word, if we want security, let us give security; if we want life, let us give life; if we want opportunities, let us provide opportunities. The yardstick we use for others will be the yardstick which time will use for us.'
