arrange for the Baptismal class. Both parents and godparents are
required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on
the 2nd Saturday of each month at 2:00 PM in the Grahmann
Center. Upon completion, a certificate is issued which remains
valid for a three year period. After the class is completed, then a
baptismal time will be scheduled.

I grew up in Coppell and attended the University of Dallas, entered seminary and spent the next several years studying theology and canon law in Rome.

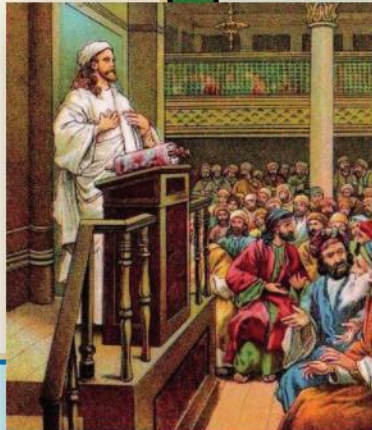
Along the way, I've served at St. Pius X, St. Patrick, here at St. Elizabeth, and most recently (last summer) at St. Francis in Lancaster.

Reconciliation TIME CHANGE

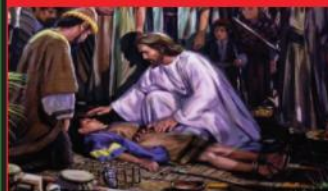
Beginning Saturday July 7th Reconciliation will no longer be in the morning from 9:30 'til 10:30 AM. The new time will be from 3:30 PM 'til

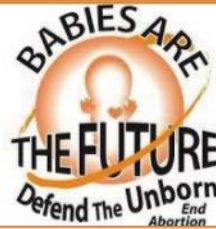
