In this week's Gospel, Jesus feeds five thousand people with five loaves and two fish. Everyone is amazed. Yet every week in our church, we feed hundreds with one bowl of bread and a few cups of wine. In the Gospel we see a pre-figuration of the Eucharistic meal. It is interesting to note that the food belonged to a boy. The food was seen as enough through the eyes of a child. Being nourished

spiritually is as important to our well-being as being nourished physically. It sustains us. That is why we conclude our celebration of the Eucharist with a prayer similar to the one below:

*May this divine sacrifice we have offered and received fill us with life, O Lord, we pray, so that, bound to you in lasting charity, we may bear fruit that lasts forever. Through Christ our Lord.*

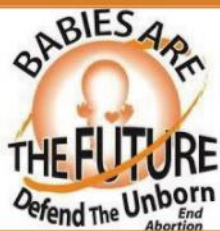

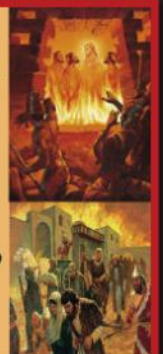
