

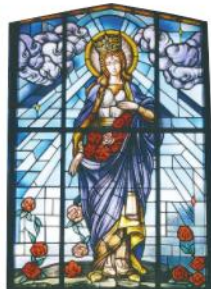

## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



Is it time to change your clothes? In today's reading from his Letter to the Ephesians, Paul tells us to put off the old person and put on the new person. The old person is the old bundle of attitudes and emotions and practices that I used to be. That's who I was before I was called out of darkness by the voice of Jesus. The new person is the

new bundle of attitudes and emotions and practices that Jesus has called us to become. Earlier in Ephesians, Paul prayed for us that we "may have power to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that we might be filled with all the fullness of God." When your mind is filled with the love of Christ and with all the fullness of God, then the spirit of your mind is renewed and freed from the deceit of the world. And out of that renewed mind come new attitudes and emotions and practices, and they clothe you with righteousness and holiness. And this new person that you become is indeed the creation of God himself, and to him belongs all the glory forever and ever. Amen.

St. John Damascene: "It was fitting that she, who had kept her virginity intact in childbirth, should keep her own body free from all corruption even after death. It was fitting that the spouse, whom the Father had taken to himself, should live in the divine mansions.
