# Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



When Jesus told His followers that He was the bread of life, He was giving them a solution—not just for their physical hunger but also for their emotional, mental, and especially their spiritual hunger. We all experience cravings—things we long to have. Many of these cravings are God-given. Acceptance is certainly something

God wants each of us to experience. The need to feel secure is a primary teaching for the Savior. He came to earth to demonstrate God's personal care for you and me. When we try to live apart from God, our own wants and needs can quickly take control of our lives and become obsessions—mental targets that we cannot achieve. We end up with feelings of loneliness or rejection, depression, anxiety, fear of loss of control, or just plain boredom. When Jesus told the people that He was the bread of life, He wasn't saying that he would fill their stomachs. He was teaching a greater truth: Whatever emotional, spiritual, or physical need we may have, He is the only One who can satisfy it. Each time we are fed with His Body and Blood, we are brought closer to fulfilling our deepest need.

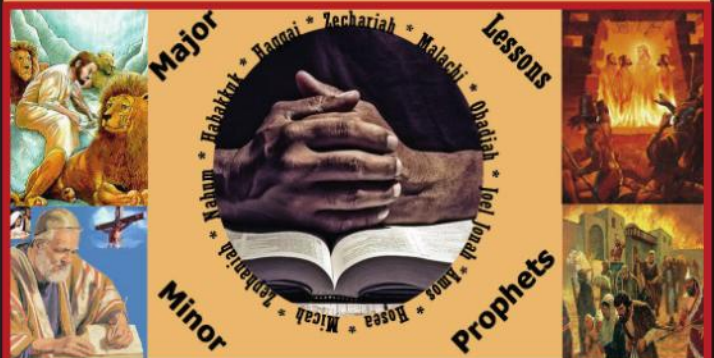
