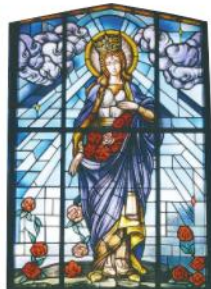

Final results can leave us all anxious, for example: the last two minutes of a football game, exams at the end of a school year, a business enterprise in which all is waged, and the end of the world. The first Christian community believed that the second coming of Christ was close, and that He would come

as the great inquisitor. Today's liturgy looks at the end of life and to what will occur later, with a clear recommendation: to be prepared. The end times will be difficult times: "For some, the verdict will be that of salvation, but for others - it will be condemnation". Do not wait for the two-minute warning. Ask yourself today, "What do I need to do to prepare for the return of the Savior?"

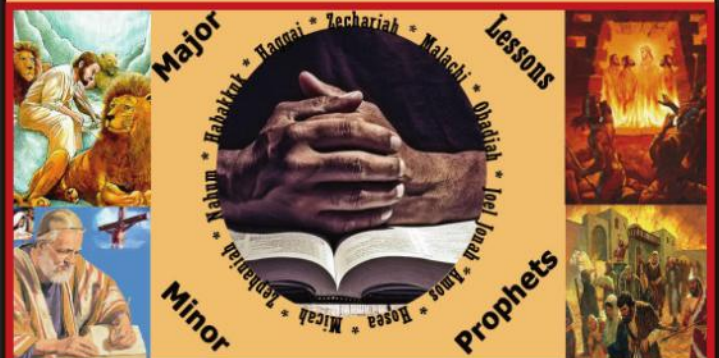
