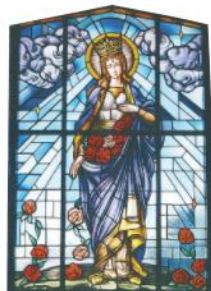

## Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

### FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



In this week's Gospel, we read about Jesus' first miracle, changing water into wine at the wedding at Cana. There must have been a huge crowd at the wedding, after all, Jesus just gave them over 100 gallons of wine. But why is there no account of how many people came to know him as the Son of God that

day. His glory was revealed, but John only comments that the disciples believed. Cana is a short distance from Nazareth, Jesus' hometown, where they later tried to throw him off a cliff. The people of Cana did not recognize the miracle that just occurred in their midst. Many times we are like that. We do not recognize the miracles which occur in our lives every day. We do not see the presence of God in others. For the last 8 years, I have met with the same prayer group on Sunday nights. One thing we ask each other is "Where did you see God this week?" Jesus brought joy to those at the wedding when he turned water into wine. Don't miss the joy of seeing Him in your life.

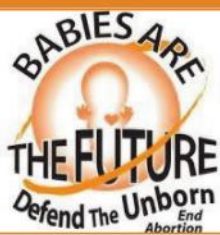
