

## Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



Today's second reading is from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. It is the most frequent scripture verse read at weddings: "Love never fails." Why is this true? Simply put, love never fails because it is something that has been instituted by God. We like to think that love is a purely human emotion,

but it has been placed in our hearts from the time we were con-

ceived. In the first reading, from the Prophet Jeremiah, He says, "Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you..." When we tell someone that we love them, we are saying that the love which God has planted in us, we choose to share with them. When a couple is married, this choice to share God's love is forever. In today's world, we have diminished the meaning of the word "Love." To say that I love my car, or I love french fries, or I love football, is a mis-statement

of the emotion. When we are taught to love our neighbor and to love our God, that is serious business. Be careful with this pre-

cious gift from God, and it will never fail.


#### **Baptismal Classes**
