First Sunday in Lent

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



We are starting one of the richest periods in the liturgical year: LENT. For 40 days, we will accompany Jesus into the desert and witness his fight with the devil and his encounter with God. of those ridiculous things that seem so urgent to us, free from our unreasonable agenda, from those unforeseen commitments, a place where we can enter into contact with the deepest sources of our being. Living in the desert means not just living apart from men, but living with God and for God. Thus the desert becomes a place to meet God. A presence that is certain, yet hidden, secret. May the Spirit that "drove Jesus into the desert" prepare us to celebrate Easter, renewed in the spirit!


