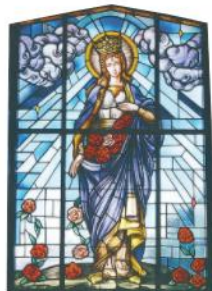

required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on

Center. Upon completion, a certificate is issued which remains
valid for a three year period. After the class is completed, then a
baptismal time will be scheduled.

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

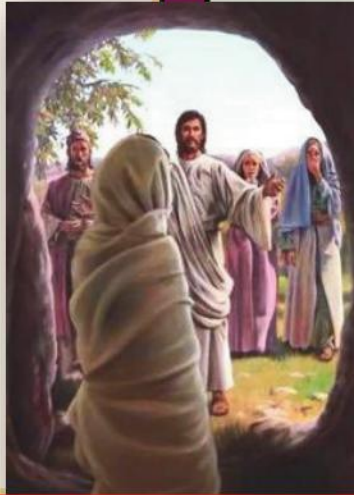


In John's gospel, we find ourselves standing outside the tomb of Lazarus, and watching the dramatic scene unfold – Christ calling out to a man who has been dead for four days. Lazarus is, literally, "The Walking Dead." But he is more than a reanimated corpse. He is a man who is given new life, and a second chance at life. And it happens for one simple reason: because Christ called—and Lazarus responded. As we near the final days of Lent, and we encounter this gospel, I look back on what this season has meant to us. It's been a time of repentance and reconciliation. Prayer and perseverance. A time of sacrifice.

And when I read these words of Christ, spoken to his dead friend, I can't help but think that he is addressing them not just to Lazarus, but to all of us. The tears that Christ shed for Lazarus are ones he sheds for all of us who are buried in caves of human weakness and sin. And so he calls to us. And he beckons us – not with a whisper, but with a cry. Have we heard him? Have we answered him? Listen for the call of Christ—the call to come out from a place of darkness. It is a call to begin again. It is a call to life.

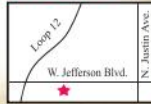
