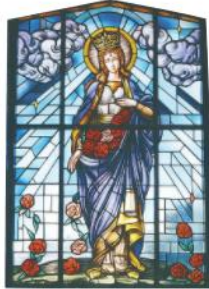

## From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar



There is a beautiful tradition in the Church, in which a newly ordained priest, at his first Mass, gives to his mother the cloth that was used in the anointing of his hands (called a manutergium). When she dies, she is buried with this cloth in her hands so that, we imagine, when she meets the Lord, and he asks "I have given you life, what have you given to me?" she hands him the manutergium and responds, "I have given you my son as a priest." Today we celebrate both Mother's Day

and Good Shepherd Sunday, so we pray in a particular way today for both mothers and priests. And we recognize the special role that families have in fostering priestly vocations. We should pray fervently for those men called to the priesthood — recognizing that they might well come from our own families — that they may respond generously and courageously to the call.

### May is National Hypertension Month.

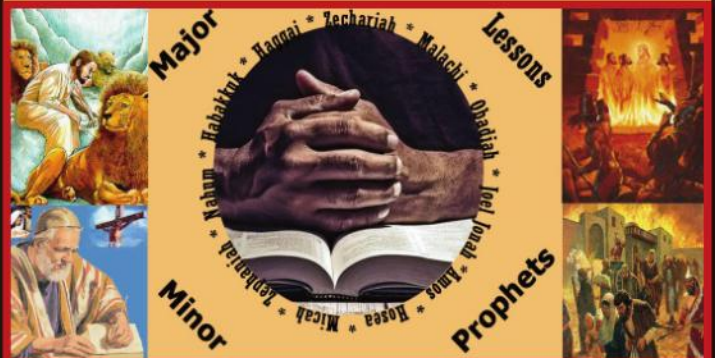
The Health Ministry will have information on Hypertension, and do blood pressure checks this week after all the masses.
