Baptism: Parents are to call Bertha at x221 or email office@stelizabethdallas.org to schedule an appointment to arrange for the Baptismal class. Both parents and godparents are required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 2:00 PM in the Grahmann Center. Upon completion, a certificate is issued which remains valid for a three year period. After the class is completed, then a baptismal time will be scheduled.

Evangelization: Children and Teen Formation: We provide a total formation program for Catholics from Pre-4 to Adult. FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



There are two things that catch my attention in today's Gospel: first, that Jesus and his disciples are always traveling. Second, Christ's constant meeting with new followers. He tells some, "Come and follow me"; others instead promise him, "I will follow you wherever you go." God calls everyone,

but not everyone answers right away. Some people make excuses. Doesn't the same thing happen to us at the important moments of life? Jesus is radical and expects us to give ourselves

completely. Being a Christian today takes courage and fortitude, because we need to overcome sentimentalism and our personal plans. The option of living according to Christ's commandments makes everything else fall into second place: work, use of time, entertainment, money. Oftentimes we will have to go against the current, when faced with customs, styles, opinions that are not in agreement with the Gospel. Only the person who understands that "the one thing

necessary" is God will be able to understand this; after that, everything else becomes relative. Our happiness depends on our complete self-giving, even though it may be countercultural or difficult. We can be sure that we will never be alone, because Christ will be with us until the last day of our lives.
