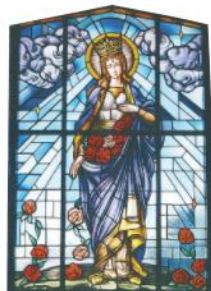

## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



If there is a perfect model of how we can welcome Jesus, we find it in the scene of Martha and Mary. Martha is working hard to serve Jesus, while Mary is seated in front of him, keeping him company and conversing with him, listening to him and being receptive to his message. Martha is active: She is busy with the work that indeed needs to be done. But her desire for order doesn't allow her to see her guest's face. Maybe she is already used to having Christ come to her house, so his presence isn't as meaningful as the first day he came.

Mary is contemplative: She prefers to be at Christ's side, listening to him and helping him rest. She was so happy that it didn't even cross her mind that she needed to get the meal ready. In our lives there are lots of important things, many duties to carry out, but we have to choose the better part: staying with Christ. Let us never regret making this choice. Let us never grow used to having Christ in our home like Martha did, getting so occupied in our own things that we forget about him. He is the source of our happiness. Our only task should be to stay with him.

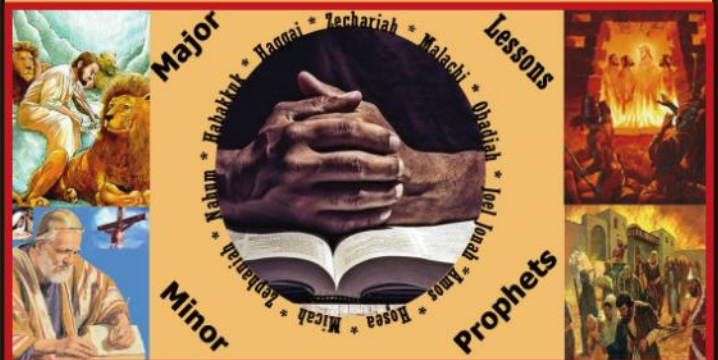
