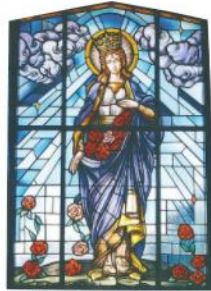

## FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



Today's readings are a wake-up call to our conscience, so we learn to place temporal goods in their proper place and use them intelligently. There are people who make material wealth the main motive behind their activities and even their life; that's all they think about. They make money into an idol

on whose altar they sacrifice their values, their family, their own health. In life we will always need to choose between opposing values, but we can only choose the best. And choosing one thing means renouncing its opposite. This Gospel passage invites us to be faithful to God. We cannot be slaves of wealth; rather we must learn to use it responsibly. Material goods will be useful only if we use them to help our neighbors in greatest need. This is the only way we can make money a means of communion with other people, instead of a means of discrimination. Money is usually a bad boss, but we can make it a good servant.

"Natural family planning (NFP) methods represent authentic family planning. They can be used both to achieve and to postpone a pregnancy. NFP makes use of periodic abstinence from sexual intercourse based upon the observation of the woman's natural signs of fertility, in order to space births or to limit the number of children when there is a serious reason to do so. NFP methods require that couples learn, accept, and live with the wonders of how God made them. This is essentially different from contraception."
