

Baptism: Parents are to call Bertha at x221 or email office@stelizabethdallas.org to schedule an appointment to arrange for the Baptismal class. Both parents and godparents are required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 2:00 PM in the Grahmann Center. Upon completion, a certificate is issued which remains valid for a three year period. After the class is completed, then a baptismal time will be scheduled.

Evangelization: Children and Teen Formation: We provide a total formation program for Catholics from Pre-4 to Adult. 

#### FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR



Our Opening Prayer today speaks of God's power: "Almighty and merciful God, you break the power of evil and make all things new in your Son Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe." When asked "What exactly is the kingship of Christ?", Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI said: "It is not that of the kings and of the great of this world; it is the divine power to

give eternal life, to liberate from evil, to defeat the dominion of death. It is the power of Love that can draw good from evil,

soften a hardened heart, bring peace to the bitterest conflict, turn the thickest darkness into hope. This Kingdom of Grace is never imposed and always respects our freedom" (Angelus, November 22, 2009). Unlike so many earthly rulers, the legitimacy of His power is not demonstrated by external force. Instead, His goodness and power attract us and summon us, revealing to us the DEEP-EST truth concerning our life and who we are. Again and again, the Lord says to his disciples and to us, "But who do you say that I am?" He bids us to freely confess him and to follow him, so to reign with him.



### **Daily Mass Schedule Change**




