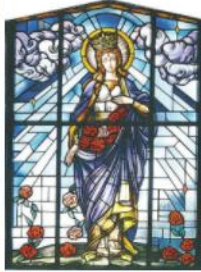

Baptism: Parents are to call Bertha at x221 or email
office@stelizabethdallas.org to schedule an appointment to
arrange for the Baptismal class. Both parents and godparents are
required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on
the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:00-11:30 AM in the
Grahmann Center. Upon completion, a certificate is issued which
remains valid for a three year period. After the class is completed,
then a baptismal time will be scheduled.

Second Sunday of Lent

From the Desk of the Pastoral Administrator



When it comes to charitable giving, we can distinguish three types. The first is Tithing, which provides the local Church with the resources needed especially for divine worship and the sustenance of the clergy, but also for the upkeep of facilities, operations, and works of the apostolate. The second is Philanthropy, which might support specific causes, like a school or hospital or research. The third is Almsgiving, which is assistance to the poor.

During the season of Lent, we are especially encouraged to give alms. As our Holy Father, Pope Francis, writes in *Evangelii Gaudium*, "there is an inseparable bond between our faith and the poor." He goes on to state that "none of us can think we are exempt from concern for the poor and for social justice." We should embrace this aspect of the Christian life wholeheartedly.

This parish has a thriving apostolate dedicated to the assistance of the poor. I am so grateful for the work of our local Society of St. Vincent de Paul, and your contributions that fuel its efforts. We take up a second collection four times per year at all Masses, called the "Black Bag Collection", to enable them to continue to provide assistance to those in need. I warmly encourage you to consider giving generously this weekend (and throughout the year) to support this important apostolate, and perhaps even to join the team as a "Vincentian." Another apostolate that seeks to alleviate the needs of the poor is Catholic Relief Services (CRS). While our Vincentians assist those in need in our community, CRS provides assistance primarily to poor communities overseas. You may have noticed the "rice bowls" placed in baskets around the church: your contributions to the Rice Bowl initiative go directly to feeding the hungry. We will also take up a second collection for CRS on the weekend of March 18-19, to benefit their disaster-relief efforts in Turkey and Syria.
