From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar



Jesus the inexhaustible fountain of life. The theme of the third Sunday in Lent centers around the need of water for human survival. Understood in the optics of its message for us, is the invitation to thirst and desire to have the life of Christ in us. Jesus is the source of everlasting life. He requests us to thirst for the water that leads to everlasting life which only He can give.

Having gone two weeks into Lent, what is the weather like in your heart? What

are the desires burning in you? Have we started feeling a sense of something positive changing in our lives? Probably, it is still a big struggle having obtaining the spiritual growth we expected. It can also be that we strongly feel tempted with the nostalgia of the old life of sin we intend to abandon.

This week invites us to take a further step by putting ourselves in the scene of this beautiful encounter of the Samaritan woman with Jesus. The Samaritan woman moved from her fears and prejudices to a true encounter with Jesus. She resembles many of us in our search for that inner peace that adds special beauty to life. Let us find time to dialogue with Jesus alone to clarify the stormy weather in our spiritual journey.

The Samaritan woman has had five husbands none of which was able to give her a stable, peaceful and happy life. Like her, we might have had so many different things or idols in life that we considered a true source of happiness, which eventually turned out to offer only a too shallow happiness. Probably we are still trying other shallow sources of happiness. Let us make a bold change.

While we think that our sins and mistakes in life have separated us from God, let these words from the second reading reinvigorate us. "For Christ, while we were still helpless, died at the appointed time for the ungodly."

It is time for us therefore to hold on to the only source of water of life that satisfies forever, the thirst for happiness in God. Let us drink from the abundance of this living water that wells up to everlasting life. And through Him to become true worshippers and adorers in spirit and truth of the only living God.




Parish Lenten Mission March 19, 20, & 21 2023




