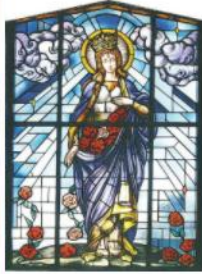

Baptism: Parents are to call Bertha at x221 or email
office@stelizabethdallas.org to schedule an appointment to
arrange for the Baptismal class. Both parents and godparents are
required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on
the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:00-11:30 AM in the
Grahmann Center. Upon completion, a certificate is issued which
remains valid for a three year period. After the class is completed,
then a baptismal time will be scheduled.

Evangelization: Children and Teen Formation: We provide a total
formation program for Catholics from Pre-4 to Adult. For

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

From the Desk of the Pastoral Administrator



The week between Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday is rightly called Holy Week, as some of the most solemn liturgies, commemorating some of the most central mysteries of our faith, take place during this time.

On Tuesday evening, the priests of the Diocese of Dallas will gather at the Cathedral to celebrate the Chrism Mass with our Bishop. Not only are the Holy Oils for initiation and anointing consecrated at this Mass, but the priests also renew our priestly promises there each year. Please pray for us especially this week!

On Holy Thursday evening at 7:30 pm, please join us as we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper, in which we commemorate the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood. We will distribute the Precious Blood at this Mass for those who desire to receive (and are properly prepared). At the end of the Mass, we will process with the Eucharist to an Altar of Repose in the Grahmann Center, where some of us will stay with Him and "keep watch" into the night.

On Good Friday we will walk the Stations of the Cross at noon. Then in the evening at 7:30 pm, we will commemorate our Lord's passion and cross in the Good Friday Liturgy. At this liturgy, we hear John's account of the Passion, and then come forward to venerate the Cross. I understand that it is customary here for the congregation to remove their shoes during the veneration of the Cross. What a beautiful devotion!

Finally, on Holy Saturday night at 8:30 pm, we celebrate the Easter Vigil. This most joyful liturgy of the year is not to be missed, if you don't mind staying up late: it typically lasts around three hours. One highlight of this Mass (among many) will be the baptism of the catechumens and the reception into full communion and full initiation of those already baptized. It will be a big moment for our parish, and I'd love to have you join us if you're able.

Please note that during Holy Week, we will not have our regularly scheduled morning Masses on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday. Nor will confession be available Holy Saturday afternoon. Fr. Uche and I will, however, be available to hear confessions on Wednesday evening, April 5th, from 5pm until 8pm.

Wishing you a blessed Holy Week and Triduum. Let's pray for each other.
