Baptism: Parents are to call Bertha at x221 or email office@stelizabethdallas.org to schedule an appointment for the Baptismal class. Both parents and godparents are required to take the class. These classes are held in our parish on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:00-11:30 AM in the Grahmann Center. Only after the class and all documentation is received, may a baptismal time will be scheduled.

Evangelization: Children and Teen Formation: We provide a total formation program for Catholics from Pre-4 to Adult. The Ascension of the Lord

From the Desk of the Pastoral Administrator



This weekend I celebrate the seventh anniversary of my ordination to the Priesthood. I am so grateful to God for this gift! I'd like to share a bit about my vocation story here, and ask all of you to join me in fostering a culture of vocations in our parish.

As I have mentioned before, I grew up in a loving family in the Dallas area, and although we

didn't always attend Sunday Mass — I joke sometimes that we were "below-average Catholics" — my parents saw to it that we attended faith formation at our parish. I remember feeling the call to the priesthood already as a second-grader when I made my first Holy Communion, but I figured I was probably imagining it, and forgot about it.

It wasn't until I was preparing for Confirmation in the 10th grade that I was confronted with the fact that I wasn't living well as a disciple of Christ — and if the Gospel was true, I needed to act like it. Once again, in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament on a retreat, I heard the Lord calling me to be His priest, but I was afraid, and knew I wasn't ready to say yes. He said to me: "don't say 'no', just 'not yet".

Encountering our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament changed my life. I started to make Him my top priority, and over time I eventually got to the point where I was able to accept the call to the priesthood with joy.

Of course it helped that a culture of vocations thrived in my home parish: we had good priests assigned there who clearly loved being priests; we had frequent Eucharistic adoration, with an emphasis on asking our Lord for more priests; and we had top-notch faith formation and youth group programs.

Thanks be to God, we have much of this present at St. Elizabeth already, and a great school besides. Our Lord is almost certainly calling some of our young people here to follow Him in the priesthood and/or religious life. Will you join me in supporting these vocations through prayer, service, and encouragement?


