From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar



"As the Father has sent me, so I send you".

Moving from the idea of a static 'Church membership' 'missionary discipleship' is one of the fundamental invitations that Pope Francis calls all Christian faithful to engage in. A Christian disciple is one who follows Jesus Christ by building a personal relationship with Him. A missionary is one who is receives the mandate to go forth and

spread the Gospel. Thus, as a mutually complimentary concept formed from the two words above, a 'missionary disciple' is one who recognizes that by baptism he/she has encountered the love of Christ and is consequently substantially called to become an agent of evangelization.

We often wrongly understand missionaries as professional peoples like priests, nuns and few laities specially trained and sent to mission lands in Africa, Asia and Latin America. It is in relation to this erroneous idea that Pope Francis says, "in virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples (Mt 28:19). All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization, and it would be insufficient to envisage a plan of evangelization to be carried out by professionals while the rest of the faithful would simply be passive recipients" (Evangelii Gaudium § 120). Thus, even though, not excluding them totally, missionary discipleship goes beyond the idea of professional ministers or missionaries destined to a certain geographical sector of the world.

The Pentecost event empowered the apostles to be missionary disciples to all the ends of the earth beginning from Jerusalem. Today, that same Holy Spirit is calling us all as the baptized Christians of this parish, to be missionary disciples of Jesus in our families, parish communities, neighborhood, in School and workplaces. Let us swing into action with the gifts and charisms of the Holy Spirit in us. Let us be committed missionary disciples, full of zeal to renew the face of the earth by the Holy Spirit given to us. Let us ask ourselves what I can do to bring someone to experience the transforming and saving encounter with Jesus Christ.

Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of the faithful. And enkindle in them the fire of your love!


