Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the Desk of the Pastoral Administrator



I watched a short film on FORMED.org recently about the Eucharistic Miracle at Bolsena that helped reinvigorate the Church's ancient faith in the True Presence in the 13th century, and prompted the creation of the Feast of Corpus Christi, which we celebrated just a few weeks ago. (On a personal note, I had the privilege of making a pilgrimage to Bolsena just a few days after I was ordained, and was able to celebrate one of my first Masses there, and participate in a Eucharistic procession.)

The video is a dramatization of a priest's crisis of faith, leading him to make a pilgrimage to Rome to pray for a miracle to help him believe. Many people still today — even some priests included, sadly — struggle with the belief that Christ is truly present in the Host.

Part of this difficulty comes from the fact that it isn't something we can perceive with our physical senses: we have to take it on faith, based on the testimony of our Lord in Scripture (eg. Mt. 26:26-28, Jn. 6:53-57) and the consistent teaching of the Church through the ages.

Another aspect of this is the witness of those around us. If it seems like nobody else believes something, it's very difficult to go against the crowd. But if our fellow parishioners manifest belief in the Real Presence, it will strengthen our faith and that of others who struggle.

So how can we better manifest our belief in the Real Presence? Well, first and foremost, by letting our Lord sanctify us and increase our love for others every time we receive Holy Communion. Beyond this, by things like engaging prayerfully in Mass & Eucharistic adoration, and receiving Holy Communion reverently (and only when properly disposed). And of course we should never refer to the consecrated Host as "bread", nor the Precious Blood as "wine".

By the way, if you're interested in watching this video (called "Faith Prevails: The Miracle of Bolsena") or others like it, the parish has a subscription to FORMED.org where you can watch all sorts of formative Catholic content for free.
